## MEETING MINUTES

Attendees: Jim Baumann, Jim Dudley, Yuhua Li, Pat Soderholm, Cindy Statz, Leann Tigges

### I. Reports

A. Treasurer: current balance is \$7122.49 less outstanding expenses including Jim B. (\$22.53), Jim D. (\$37), 2017 water bill, and Community GroundWorks 10% garden plot fees for New Garden fund.

B. Registrar: 3-4 more since last meeting

C. Timekeeper: 3 people have no hours; 9 people have less than 4 hours

### II. Unfinished Business

A. Formal response to grants: Power Point presentation of water service installation will be provided by Statz for review.

B. City of Madison study of additional garden space – next steps: public discussion regarding three options in Hill Farms area including Bordner Park, Indian Hills Park, and Rennebohm Park. Statz and Tigges will work together to send notice to past gardeners for interest.

Baumann and Statz will pursue soil sampling in Bordner and Indian Hills.

At the DOT site, <10% of gardeners selected the option for a ~100SF garden plot; survey existing gardeners to determine interest in larger plots, compost area, etc. Statz to develop public notice with Jim D.'s garden photo with rip tags for distribution in area multi-family housing, area businesses, etc.

City of Madison has budgeted ~\$60,000 for the development of the additional garden space. SACG will seek to submit new grant applications in advance of 2018 garden expansion.

C. City of Madison herbicide usage: tabled until early 2018
